The Carrollton Township Board will conduct Public Hearings at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, March 20, 2017 for the purpose of taking comments reference the proposed spreading of 2017 levies on real property for Trash Collection and for Police and Fire Protection Special Assessment districts. Appearance and protest at the hearing in the special assessment proceedings is required in order to appeal the amount of the special assessment to the state tax tribunal and shall be made in the following manner: An owner or party in interest or his or her agent may appear in person at the hearing to protest the special assessment, or shall be permitted to file his or her appearance or protest by letter and his or her personal appearance shall not be required.

The Carrollton Township Board will conduct a public hearing on the proposed Fiscal Year 2017-2018 township budgets at 5:40 p.m. on Monday, March 20, 2017. The property tax millage rate proposed to be levied to support the proposed budget will be a subject of this hearing. The budgets will be available for examination during regular business hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday thru Friday at the Township Office located at 1645 Mapleridge Rd.

The Carrollton Township Board will provide necessary reasonable auxiliary aids and services, such as signers for the hearing impaired and audio tapes of printed materials being considered at the meeting to individuals with disabilities by calling Office Manager Megan Weaver at 754-4611.
