Code Enforcement Officer Position Filled



Carrollton Township has hired Jon Jozwiak to fill the vacant Code Enforcement Officer position. Jon started on July 6, 2017 and has been very active with enforcement actions. We are introducing Jon to the public; however, if you keep your property and homes up to an acceptable standard - you'll probably never have to meet him!

Jon will be enforcing all Municipal Civil Infractions that the Carrollton Township has in its Code of Ordinances. If you receive a ticket from Jon, please look at the bottom section of your copy of the ticket for instructions on where to pay the ticket. If Carrollton Township's address appears on the ticket, it is payable at the Violation Bureau at Carrollton Township Offices located at 1645 Mapleridge Rd. If the ticket has the address of 111 South Michigan Ave. on it, then that ticket is payable at the Saginaw County Courthouse.

Examples of ordinances that result in municipal civil infractions if violated:

- ♦ **Running a business without a business license** – Chapter 18, Article II
- ♦ **Dismantled Motor Vehicles** – Chapter 22, Article IV
- ♦ **Soliciting to residents without a permit** – Chapter 18, Article III
- ♦ **Blighted Structures** – Chapter 22, Article III
- ♦ **Storage/Accumulation of Trash** – Chapter 22, Article III
- ♦ **Use of Consumer Fireworks** – Chapter 26, Article III
- ♦ **Parking of Recreational Equipment/Vehicles** – Chapter 66, Article IV

The above listing is designed to refresh our citizens' memory of the most common ordinances that are in place to improve the quality of life for Carrollton Township. CTPD is now hiring Crossing Guards for the 2017-2018 school year @ \$10.00/hr

Guards are required to work ONE HOUR on school days (30 mins in morning - 30 mins in afternoon)

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- ◆ Must be at least 18 years of age
- ◆ Must be able to hold a hand-held stop sign above the head in an upright position while in the roadway
- ◆ Must receive a minimum of 4 hours instruction
- ◆ Must have the ability to clearly observe vehicle and pedestrian traffic at acceptable distances and to hear at an acceptable level
- ◆ Must possess the ability to work effectively with children
- ◆ Must be able to display good judgment and respond quickly to emergencies
