New Ordinance: Storage of Garbage Prior to Collection Day

On June 11, 2018, the Township Board passed Ordinance No. 2018-01 which amends Chapter 42, Solid Waste, Sec. 42-20 and Division 2, Sec. 42-57 and Sec. 42-58. The last section contains the most amended language that now reads:

“Storage prior to collection. All trash cans, waste material, debris, refuse, recycling, yard waste, garbage cans, or garbage shall be kept in a place not readily noticeable. Storage shall be away from places occupied by other persons. Any type of container capable of storing the items specifically listed above shall be reasonably hidden from a citizen’s view from the road. Citizens shall take reasonable precautions while storing the above listed items so they cannot be easily disturbed by animals. Other than the time allotted by ordinance for collection; none of the above listed items shall be stored in the front of any residence.”

REMINDER! All garbage containers must be no more than 35 gallons and cannot weigh more than 50 pounds. Garbage is collected by Waste Management on **THURSDAY** of every week for *all* of Carrollton Township (except when a major holiday occurs, then collection is delayed until Friday). Residents may place their garbage at the curb after 6:30pm the day prior to collection and cans shall be removed when emptied the same day of collection.

The purpose of this amended ordinance is to continue our “Fight the Blight” campaign! Thank you for helping us clean up Carrollton Township!

MESSAGE FROM THE CTPD - BEWARE OF SCAMMERS!

Our #1 priority is to keep our citizens safe, so we urge you to be cautious when receiving telephone calls or emails from people asking you to send them money or allow access to your bank accounts. Here are some examples of those types of requests:

- ◆ You receive a telephone call saying that a family member has been arrested and needs money mailed to them
- ◆ You receive an email stating that the IRS or Court system will be issuing a warrant for your arrest if you don't send money to pay a fine
- ◆ You have won Publisher's Clearing House and need to send money first to pay the taxes on your reward

When is my summer 2018 property tax bill due?

Summer taxes are due **Friday, September 14, 2018**. In order for taxes to be considered paid on time, your payment must be received in the Treasurer's Office *on or before Sept. 14*. Postmarks will not be accepted. Payments may be made by cash, check, money order or credit/debit card (fees apply).
