Approved Road Millage Funding Plans Underway

YOU, the citizens of Carrollton Township, passed a Road Improvement Millage request in March of 2020. The passing of the millage request will allow for much needed work to go into repairing the Carrollton Township Road System. Your YES vote, was an investment to make our community better!

Carrollton Township Elected Officials and Staff thank you for the vote of confidence which gives us the financial strength to improve our roads. Using a scale called PASER, (Pavement Surface Evaluation and Rating) to rate the condition of our roads, most are rated in *poor* condition. The collection of the millage money began with your 2020 Winter Property Tax bill that was received around December 1, 2020.

Every single penny that is collected will be used on road improvements in Carrollton Township.

Elected Township Officials are working with a committee made up of citizens that provide input to the Township Board to help select road projects. *If you do not see any immediate work on the street you live on, please do not get upset. This millage will generate money for road improvements for the next twenty years ending in 2039.* Obviously, we cannot repair every single road at once. We have been preparing through these winter months to set a systematic approach to road repairs that ensures improvements all over the township.

During the summer months you will start to see road improvements being made. Road work is scheduled for: North Michigan, Mapleridge, Schust, Venoy and Tittabawassee. While equipment is in this area, the Township Board may look to supplement additional road work in this area of the township. However, as I previously stated, ***road improvements will be made across all areas of the township.***

At their March 4, 2021 Special Meeting, the Township Board approved two road projects for the Spring/Summer 2021 construction season: **Atlanta St.** (from Bauer to Church) for an estimated cost of \$201,362 and **Skyhaven** (from N. Michigan to Ventura) for an estimated cost of \$138,443. Both of these will be paid for with the Road Tax Millage collections.

I mentioned Township Board members are receiving input from citizens that have been involved with this process from the start. The Saginaw County Road Commission has been a great community partner as well, advising us and providing plenty of support in the decision-making process. They are very engaged in seeing the Carrollton Township Road Millage provide our citizens and visitors safe roads to travel on!

Beginning March 1, 2021, Carrollton Township Offices are OPEN to public walk-ins. Please wear a mask when entering the Township Office (unless you have a medical reason preventing you from wearing one). **We strongly encourage residents to continue using the Drive-Up Dropbox located in the front parking lot.** To contact the Township Office, you may call: 989-754-4611 or visit our website: www.carrolltontwp.com/Offices/ to email a specific employee or department. ATTENTION RESIDENTS WITH A DELINQUENT BALANCE ON THEIR WATER/SEWER ACCOUNT

Beginning April 1, 2021, Carrollton Township DPW will resume the disconnection of water service for those residents that have a past-due balance.
