### **Did You Know?**

The Carrollton Township Fire Dept. keeps a list of citizens with special needs that would require extra assistance in an emergency. If you would like to be added to this list or know someone who should be added, please include the name of resident, address, location resident can normally be found inside the home, whether there is extra equipment required (i.e. oxygen tank/machine) and phone number of resident and emergency contact info. ## **Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)**

### **How do I contact the Police Department after office hours?**

The Police Department's office hours are Monday thru Friday, 8am-5pm. For assistance *after* office hours - **call 911** and tell the dispatcher that you have a *non-emergency issue* and you need assistance from the on-duty Carrollton Township police officer. Central Dispatch will have the on-duty officer get in contact with you. *Carrollton Township has 24/7 police protection!*

### **Is there a way to look up the Township's ordinances online?**

### **When does the Township collect unused/unwanted pills?**

Carrollton Township Police Dept. participates in the DEA's National Take-Back Initiative with drop-off days twice a year (Apr/Oct); however, we also have a convenient drop box located in the front lobby where pills can be discarded safely during business hours. Please empty all pills into a ziploc bag - no liquids, patches, or syringes!
