Carrollton Township Partners with Gift of Life Michigan



The office of Carrollton Township Clerk Jerry Fritz is one of a growing number of municipal clerks that are partnering with Gift of Life Michigan to help residents sign up to save lives by joining the Michigan Organ Donor Registry.

Gift of Life is the federally designated organ and tissue recovery organization for Michigan. It serves as the connection between families, hospitals and transplant centers as it works to fulfill the wishes of donors and their families.

It also collaborates with the Michigan Department of State, which houses the Michigan Organ Donor Registry, a secure database of those who have documented their decision to help others. "We cannot thank your office enough for recognizing the urgent need to increase the number of registered donors in your area and across the entire state," said Dorrie Dils, president and CEO at Gift of Life. "By encouraging your residents to register and providing the link for them to do so, I promise you are saving lives."



ORGAN AND TISSUE DONATION

The Donor Registry must grow to help the 2,400 critically ill patients waiting in Michigan for a lifesaving organ transplant. About 106,000 people need transplants nationwide. For some, their gift doesn't come in time: *Seventeen people die every day waiting in the U.S., and one person is added to the national list every 9 minutes.* Please consider documenting your decision to donate life at golm.org and share this link with your friends and family!!

Winter Property Taxes Coming Out December 1st

Your winter property tax bill should be in your mailbox on or around **December 1, 2022**. If you do not receive one, please make sure to call the Township Office and we will send you a duplicate. **The Township can not be responsible for the U.S. Postal Service.** To avoid penalty, you must pay your taxes by **Tuesday, February 14, 2023**. A 3% penalty will be applied to all unpaid tax bills on February 15. You may still pay the amount (with penalty) at the Township Office up until **Tuesday, February 28, 2023**. Beginning March 1, 2023 - all 2022 property taxes MUST be paid at the Saginaw County Treasurer's Office located at the Court House, 111 S. Michigan Ave. 48602.

Do you still owe your 2022 summer property taxes?? You may pay those at the Township Office up until February 28, 2023. Please be sure to call and get the payoff amount as interest has been applied each month since the summer tax due date of Sept. 14, 2022.

Partial payments are accepted for property taxes - however, penalties and interest will be applied to the remaining unpaid balance and *all unpaid bills will be forwarded to the Saginaw County Treasurer's Office for collection on March 1, 2023.*

All payments must be received in the Township Office by the due dates. **Postmarks are NOT accepted!** You may also use our convenient Drive-Up Dropbox located in the front parking lot. If you don't mind paying a convenience fee, you may also pay your tax bill online at **www.carrolltontwp.com** or by phone at **1-855-825-0553**. You will need your parcel ID number from your tax bill.
